Local Rules - The Seely Course

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - Beyond any fence or hedge bordering the course.
 - In the car park.
 - On the Driving Range.
 - Beyond the white posts beyond the 18th green.
 - To left of the 1st and 2nd fairways, defined by white posts.
 - Over the hedge to the left of the 9th fairway, as far as the green keeper's gate.
 - When playing the 9th hole the tarmac road and beyond it is deemed to be out of bounds.
- STONES AND BUNKERS (RULE 24-1)**

Stones in the bunkers are movable obstructions, and may be removed without penalty.

- WINTER GREENS (Rule 25-1)**

If a player's ball lies in an area GUR from which play is prohibited, or if such an area of GUR interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing the player must take relief.
- WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)**

The ponds on the 6th, 9th and 15th holes (marked with yellow posts).
- SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**

All pop up sprinkler heads, travelling sprinklers and their hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2b (within one club length of the nearest point of relief). In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

To ensure everyone enjoys their game of golf to the full please observe the following: It is the duty of every golfer to keep pace with the game in front (and not just ahead of those behind).
Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers.
Please keep trolleys and bags off tees and green aprons.
Players must have their own bag of clubs. Sharing a set of clubs is not permitted. Please observe the dress code.

INSURANCE & SAFETY

Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure no one is in range, before playing a shot.
